Mount Angel. The 45th annual Oktoberfest runs from Thursday, September 16 through Sunday, September 19. Every year over 350,000 people come to Mount Angel for the weekend of their lives. They are drawn to the tiny rural community, 40 miles south of Portland, Oregon, by its beautiful countryside, Bavarian charm – and one of the greatest folk festivals in the Northwest.

There is something for everyone at Oktoberfest: Over 50 little food chalets laden with rich, delicious Bavarian treats; a large arts and crafts show full of treasures to take home; a traditional Biergarten, family Weingarten and interactive family Alpinegarten. There is free entertainment on the village bandstand featuring all of the great sounds of the alpine country and a free Kindergarten on Saturday and Sunday. Enjoy a sports program that includes golf and volleyball tournaments and a high school football classic, a 200-vehicle cruz-n car show and so much more.

Mount Angel Oktoberfest Facts

When: 11 a.m. 'till Midnight, Thursday, Friday & Saturday,
September 16, 17 & 18.
10:00 a.m. to 9:30 p.m. Sunday, September 19.

Where: The village of Mount Angel, approximately 40 miles south of Portland and 20 miles north of Salem on US Highway 214. Coming from the north take I-5 Exit 271 at Woodburn; from the south use the Salem, Market St. I-5 Exit 256 and follow signs through Silverton to Mount Angel.

FREE: Admission to the festival area. Parking is \$4.00 all day. Free shuttle provided from distant parking lots.

FREE: Continuous, live entertainment on the Village Bandstand from Noon until closing each day of the festival.

FREE: Friday and Saturday Night Street Dances with the Country Dutchmen.

FREE: Kindergarten open Saturday and Sunday from 11:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Wiener Dog Races, Kids programs, clowns, 4H petting farm, face painting and more.

FREE: Cruz-n Car Show on Saturday and Sunday. More than 100 vehicles each day representing the best from the 30's to date.

FREE: Concerts in Historic St. Mary Church all four days of the festival.

You don't need a pocket full of dollars to enjoy this great folk festival. Most events are free! There is a small cover charge to enter the festival gardens.

The organizers of Oktoberfest know they have something just for you. You will not find any better food, entertainment, or dancing in the Northwest. You are sure to enjoy the good old-fashioned German hospitality Mount Angel has to offer.
