Doppel Bock beer is a monastic style

“strong beer” (the strongest beer brewed by Spaten, 7.2% alc/vol) originally brewed during the season of Lent. It is considered by many beer connoisseurs as the world's finest dark beer. It is a true bottom-fermented dark lager. (\$5.00 – in the Alpinegarten)

Spaten Oktoberfest is a richly malted amber lager with a hint of nutty sweetness. It was the beer selected for the 1810 engagement party of Bavarian Prince Ludwig and his princess Theresa,

at the first Oktoberfest in Munich. Originally a seasonal beer, it is now enjoyed throughout the year. (\$5.00 – in the Alpinegarten and Weingarten)

Germany's #1 selling beer in America

In 1873, Luder Rutenberg of Bremen, turned his success as a builder into something bigger, bolder and **brewed**. He hired the best brewmaster, Heinrich Beck and the rest is history.

Beck's Classic German Pilsner is made from the

Hofbräu Original embodies Munich's character as a city of beer, spreading its fame throughout the world. Full-bodied and offering a truly fine hops aroma, it is a refreshing, crisp and superbly well-balanced Bavarian lager. (\$5.00 – in the Alpinegarten)

Hofbräu Dunkel the archetypal Bavarian dark beer. This was the first type of beer to be brewed at Hofbräuhaus when it was founded over 400 years ago. It is still as popular as ever. It has a subtle spicy and rich flavor. It is a refreshing beer that suits all kinds of occasions. A beer in the traditional Munich style!

Paulaner Pilsner is brewed in strict accordance with the traditional Pilsen brewing method using hops from the Hallertau. Its light color and stiff foam distinguish it from other beers. By the way, although Pils originally comes from Bohemia, it was first produced by a Bavarian brewer. Pilsner has always been a strong favorite in Bavaria; the rest of world today is no less appreciative of its fine, dry flavor.

Paulaner Hefeweissbier is a world class high quality light tasting wheat beer. It is Paulaner's best-selling beer. Specially produced top-fermented yeast is what gives it its unmistakable character - sparkling light, fruity, and just a tiny bit bitter. Because it is not filtered during the brewing process, it retains its originality and the many vitamins, minerals and trace elements.

The unfiltered ale combines malt, white wheat and oats, giving the Belgian White its signature cloudy appearance and smooth full taste.



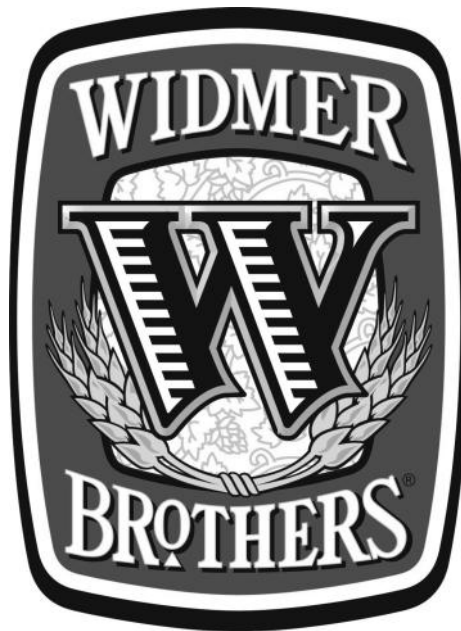

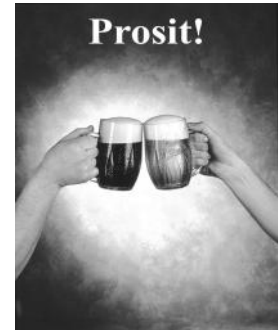
