

Widmer Beers - 6 tokens

Deutschland IPA: Deutschland IPA was specifically brewed for Mt. Angel Oktoberfest and is a German interpretation of an American classic. Tons of German hops, both traditional noble hops and newer varieties were added to the kettle, whirlpool & fermenter to give the beer lots of flavor and aromatics. The grain bill is simple, only utilizing 2-Row & CaraHell malt. **ABV: 7.4% IBU: 63**

Fossil Fuel Stein Bier: A modern attempt to make a stein bier which is an old-world technique of superheating rocks to boil beer wort. This creates some caramelization & a tiny nuance of smoke. This light Amber Lager, Stein bier is delicate enough to allow the malt characters to dominate, yet still provides a floral, slightly spicy finish. **ABV: 5.5% IBU: 18**

FH Steinbock: This traditional bock boasts full-bodied malt bill including Weyermann Pilsner and Munich which give a toasty malty backbone and a clean smooth caramel finish. Hallertau hops impart earthy aromas and soft bitterness. Bavarian yeast rounds out this celebratory ale. **ABV 6.0% IBU 30**

Warpin' Dorphin

It is packed with some modern classics such as Mosaic, Simcoe and Azacca, & has the slightly newer hop called Bru-1. Hops are added in the last 10 minutes of the boil. Allowing more flavor and aromatics, but keeping the bitterness in check. Notes of citrus & tropical fruit dominate. Very flavorful and can proudly be called a true American IPA. **ABV: 6.2% IBU: 70**

Alt

Alt beer is a traditional German ale, an assertively bitter beer with a clean, dry, roasted finish & a deep amber hue. Assertive hop bitterness is balanced by the flavor of the Munich & Caramel specialty malts. Subtle roasted barley & chocolate malt notes add color, flavor, and complexity to this delicious beer. **ABV 5.0% IBU 35**

Spaten Lager-

Spaten is a classic German Helles premium lager, with a light, crisp taste and golden in color. Offers a full rounded body of malty sweetness, balanced by delicate hop flavors and aromas. **ABV: 5.2%; IBU: 21**

Spaten Optimator-


The classic German dark beer, bottom fermented 'Doppel Bock'. Full bodied with a deep dark color and rich roasted malt flavor. **ABV: 7.6%; IBU: 20**

Spaten Marzen (Oktoberfest)-

World's First Oktoberfest Beer. The beer of Munich's famous Oktoberfest: aromatic, savory, gold-colored. **ABV: 5.9%; IBU: 23**

Franziskaner Hefe- Weissebier-

Premium Hefe-Weissbier From Munich. The copper golden wheat beer unfolds with an aromatic fragrance and harmonious banana and citrus fruits. **ABV: 5.0%; IBU: 12**

10 Barrel Beers - 6 tokens

Pub Beer Lager: Floral hops are present with a slight spice and pear character. Pub Beer is light and crisp with high carbonation and a minor creamy mouthfeel. This beer was made to drink a few. **ABV: 5 IBU: 14**

Hoptoberfest Lager: IPL (India Pale Lager) This beer was designed to celebrate the Mt Angel Oktoberfest. We took a traditional lager and added a little NW flare to it. We achieved this with the use of domestic and imported hops melded with a traditional lager malt bill. It also will be a little more warming for those brisk autumn nights. Prost! **ABV: 6.4% IBU: 50**

Swill Grapefruit Radler: Beer guy! Stop taking yourself so serious... our Swill was designed to throw down. We started with a base of German Berliner Weiss and added multiple layers of grapefruit to this summer crusher! **ABV: 4.5% IBU: 4**

Baywindow Berliner: This traditional Sour German Wheat Beer, has a soft wheat malt body with a clean tartness and crisp finish. Baywindow Berliner is a true sessionable sour ale. Prost! **ABV: 5 IBU: 5**

Smooth Talker: This classic German Pilsner is a favorite of the Brewers. We use Noble hops to give it the authentic hop character you expect from a Pilsner and a crisp finish. Made with tradition and exceptional quality in mind. **ABV: 5 IBU: 35**

Oktoberfest: A fuller-bodied pale lager, while still crisp, slightly sweet but well-balanced and flavorful, with beautiful, deep amber color. Oktoberfest boast sweet toasted bread aroma, with faint hints of spice, noticeable Noble hop bite, and a dry finish. **ABV: 5.8% IBU: 20**

Young Squeazy: Some may call the "New England IPA" a trend, some call it a style, we call it wicked good. With a soft malt profile, low IBU, and a huge tropical hop profile, it drinks just like fruit juice. **ABV: 6.2% IBU: 50**

10 Barrel Rotating Tap:

Beers listed below will be rotated through in no particular order. Baywindow Berliner, Smooth Talker Pilsner, Oktoberfest Marzen.

Square Mile Cider: A classic American hard cider made only with apples from the Pacific Northwest. A lager beer yeast for fermentation that perfectly balance sweet and tart with a light, crisp apple flavor and a clean refreshing finish. **ABV 6.7%**

PINOT NOIR - \$7 - Our Pinot Noir is a food-friendly red wine that exhibits appealing aromas of black cherry, plum and a hint of bittersweet cocoa powder. Sourced from vineyards throughout the Willamette Valley and Southern Oregon, we've created balance through complexity and diversity.

PINOT GRIS - \$6 - Sourced from vineyards throughout Oregon, our Pinot Gris shows ripe fruit aromas of tropical pineapple, zesty mango, floral banana and honeydew melon. It's balanced with peachy stone fruit, lemon-lime citrus and a subtle note of wet stones make for a complex and medium-body wine.

CHARDONNAY - \$6 - Day bright hues of gold and surprising tropical fruit aromas for this growing region showing high quality ripe grapes. Looks refreshing, smells refreshing, tastes refreshing! Soft but crisp acidity is a great palate cleanser with orange and lemon notes perfect for meal pairing.

ROSÉ OF PINOT NOIR - \$6 - This dry Rosé exhibits aromas of strawberries, cream & fresh cut watermelon with flavors of citrus fruits & crisp mouthwatering acidity. Sourced from our Seabreeze Estate, this single-vineyard Rosé is liquid sunshine in a bottle.

RED BLEND - \$7 - Sourced throughout the state of Oregon, our Red Blend is a big, bold wine. This Syrah blend was meant to be paired with smoked and cured meats. With bright red fruits driving the palate, the toasted barrel characteristics of leather and all-spice to create a full-body and well-rounded red wine.
